This is a Proposal Position. The purpose of this job posting is to identify Key Personnel for a Base Operations Support Services (BOSS) project based in Djibouti, Africa. Candidates selected for the proposal will have first consideration pending a contract award.

Manage the development, administration and implementation of environmental programs in accordance with governmental requirements. Coordinates the delivery and execution of Environmental services to support all functional areas, operations, and base personnel. Responsible for development and execution of the Site Environmental Plan. Directs, schedules, and assigns work requiring judgment and adaptation of environmental techniques, procedures and criteria.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for environmental activities related to camp operations and maintenance activities to include; execution of Hazardous Material (HM) Hazardous Waste (HW), and Biological Waste (BW) collection, storage, disposal, and waste minimization actions, and Oil and Hazardous Substances (OHS) clean up Response Teams.
- Provides ownership and control of designated Hazardous Waste Accumulation Point (HWAP) locations.
- Ensure the effectiveness of on-going pollution prevention activities, assuring compliance with structured auditing efforts.
- Review studies and environmental impact reports for new construction projects, plant processes and permit changes.
- Review and analyze environmental documentation issued by the federal EPA, state and local regulatory agencies.
- Determine impact on operational activities and publishes compliance strategies and requirements.
- Evaluate proposed regulations to determine financial, industrial, public and environmental impact.
- Interact with federal, state and local regulators to resolve compliance issues; establish permit requirements and assist in EPA, state and local regulatory audits.
- Represent the Company in government and industry rule-making activities.

- Participates fully in advancement of project Business Operating System (BOS), and Process improvements development and refinement of Business Processes (BP's) Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's) and Process Improvements (PI's).
- Actively supports Corporate and Project Safety, Health and Environmental Programs.
- Develops and implements environmental policies and programs regarding environmental planning, monitoring, reporting and analyzing of related data.
- Ensures the installation environmental program complies with applicable directives including Department of Defense (DOD) Overseas Environmental Baseline Guidance Document (OEBGD) and Department of Navy DoN policies, procedures, and instructions.
- Investigates spills and writes report indicating cause and corrective action. Coordinates spill cleanups and remediation requirements.
- Writes scopes of work, calculates estimates, and solicits quotes for subcontractors to perform environmental work; provides project management and technical oversight for the same.
- Develops and provides training on a variety of environmental topics.
- Serves as liaison and consultant between project personnel and government personnel on environmental policies and regulations.

Requires:

- Bachelor degree in Engineering discipline related to job duties.
- Professional registration or certification valued.
- 5 years experience in water/wastewater treatment and experience or knowledge of environmental compliance programs.
- 40 hour Hazardous Waste Operations per 29 CFR 1910.120 Knowledge of OSHA, EPA, FDEP, applicable environmental regulatory laws,
- Demonstrated professional knowledge of DOD, DoN and Federal regulatory processes and standards.
- Position requires excellent interpersonal, oral and written communication skills, and ability to serve as a key participant in orchestrating and coordinating base level environmental programs.
- Ability to assess trends and implement strategies to correct program deficiencies as required.
- Recent experience as Navy/Marine/Army/ USAF OCONUS Environmental Manager preferred.
- Must have a current or ability to obtain DoD/DoS Secret Clearance
