This is a Proposal Position. The purpose of this job posting is to identify Key Personnel for a Base Operations Support Services (BOSS) project based in Djibouti, Africa. Candidates selected for the proposal will have first consideration pending a contract award.

Manages and leads Health Safety and Environment initiatives and personnel. Coordinates the delivery of HSE products and services to operations and shared services personnel, in support of project operations and execution. Interfaces and negotiates with clients, subcontractors and regulatory bodies. Responsible for HSE plan development to include health standards directed by regulatory agencies to prevent work site hazards and diseases. Responsible for execution of HSE training plan, and site safety programs. Accountable for HSE performance and program results within an assigned area or location (project).

Responsibilities:

- As Lead Safety Manager, coordinates the delivery of HSE products and services to operations and shared services personnel, in support of business operations and execution.
- Primary duty and responsibility entails inspection of industrial processes for compliance with applicable standards, and monitoring of HSE performance and benchmarks against the industry.
- Responsibility spans all functional areas to include Air Operations.
- Identifies and communicates best practices within and across all business sectors, and to HSE Leadership team.
- Engages in many diverse tasks including overseeing and implementation of training programs, report writing, plan development and implementation, attending meetings, and giving presentations.
- Significant supervisory and leadership responsibilities, including personnel development.
- Requires excellent organizational skills and ability to work under own initiative.
- Provides technical leadership and direction to other less experienced personnel.

- Provides expert technical advice to operations and shared services personnel.

Requires:

- Skills required for this job are typically acquired through the completion of an undergraduate degree and 7 to 10+ years of experience, 4+ of which should be in management.
- Excellent interpersonal, oral and written communication skills, and ability to serve as a key participant in orchestrating and coordinating base level health and safety programs.
- Professional registration or certification is valued.
- Demonstrated professional knowledge of OSHA, DOD, and industry HSE processes and standards, as well as strong working knowledge of health, safety and environmental requirements in OCONUS, contingency environments
- Ability to assess trends and implement strategies to correct program deficiencies and make adjustments as required
- Ability to plan and implement HSE policies and procedures set forth in OSHA, customer, and company directives
- Must have a current or ability to obtain DoD/DoS Secret Clearance
- Prefer recent experience as Navy/Marine/Army/ USAF OCONUS Site Safety and Health Officer or Manager.
