Logistics Manager

This is a Proposal Position. The purpose of this job posting is to identify Key Personnel for a Base Operations Support Services (BOSS) project based in Djibouti, Africa. Candidates selected for the proposal will have first consideration pending a contract award.

The Logistics Manager (LM) has overall responsibility and accountability for the efficient management, administration and provision of project logistics services and support; in compliance with Customer and sustainment requirements. The LM's span of logistics responsibility includes central consumption points as well as several remote diplomatic posts. The LM is responsible to plan and supervise the execution of integrated logistics operations from local, regional and international vendors and suppliers on secure Supply Routes to the consumption points. Deliver sustainment support in sufficient quantity to avoid operational culmination.

Responsibilities:

- Direct logistics operations via the TO Movement Control Center (MCC).
- Set policies and standards for the handling of dangerous goods, and ensure compliance with regulations.
- Monitor TO logistics performance, prepare reports, and plan for changes to schedules.
- Plan, organize, direct, control and evaluate subcontractors responsible for the provision of TO logistics support.
- Develop plans and procedures for the supply, transportation and storage of goods.
- Apply operations policies and standards, and determine safety procedures for the handling of dangerous goods, and ensure compliance with transport regulations.
- Oversee dispatch of TO vehicles, vessels or aircraft to maintain the uninterrupted flow of goods to the Mission Area, and from supply sources to warehouses.
- Plan, organize, direct, control and evaluate subcontractors responsible for the transportation and movement of TO goods.
- Prepare shipping documentation and oversee the scheduling, dispatching, tracking and tracing of goods in transit.

- Negotiate with carriers, warehouse operators and insurance company representatives for services and preferential rates.
- Set stocking levels for all classes of supply at all TO facilities where supplies are held.
- Coordinate requisitioning and replenishment to ensure stocking levels are sustained without interruption.
- Control the TO Logistics budget.

Requires:

- Undergraduate university degree in business administration, economics, commerce or a related field; or
- Certificate in Logistics Operations Management.
- Five years senior management logistics experience in projects of similar size and complexity.
- Military experience in logistics operations in a management role.
- Experience in contract management.
- Experience in project management.
- Experience in a logistics management position working in an austere location.
- Must have a current or ability to obtain DoD/DoS Secret Clearance
