Project Manager

This is a Proposal Position. The purpose of this job posting is to identify Key Personnel for a Base Operations Support Services (BOSS) project based in Djibouti, Africa. Candidates selected for the proposal will have first consideration pending a contract award.

The Project Manager (PM) leads the entire Contractor Project through the combined US/TCN/HN workforce to accomplish Base Operations Support (BOS) / Facility Support for the US Navy and its Tenants. Services include: Facility Support, Utility Production and Distribution, Public Safety, Supply, Ordnance, BSVE, Air Operations, MWR Services, Galley, and Environmental Services. The PM monitors work control, status visibility, planning, scheduling, resource accountability and control, performance measurements, and reports generation.

Responsibilities:

- Provides Total Contract Management to deliver all labor, supervision, tools, materials, equipment, facilities, transportation, incidental engineering within FFP and IDIQ Contract objectives.
- Manages and directs work at the Camp, and at various locations within the continent of Africa.
- Manages Contractor performance to achieve and sustain the Navy's performance-based service Contracting (PBSC) objectives.
- Co-manages the overall logistics effort to ensure availability of services and supplies within the Camp.
- Delegates, in writing, specific responsibilities to all key managers providing each with the authority over the resources commensurate with his responsibility and ensures each key manager is held accountable for the results.
- Issues policies and procedures to govern daily business operations and ensures compliance with applicable Federal and State laws, regulations and standards.
- Plans, organizes and staffs the project through a smooth mobilization and phase-in through to full contract operation and maturation.
- Sustains a community-work relations framework that includes the host country national community.

Requires:

- Bachelor's degree, and 10 years experience in various leadership roles related to facilities/installation operational and maintenance.

- Five years managing base operations services similar in size and complexity, requiring supervision of a multi-national labor force.
- Requires problem recognition, solution development and action step formulation within structured and defined judgment parameters of the job.
- Management experience implementing Lean processes (six-sigma) or process improvement techniques into a Project or Program.
- Must have a current or ability to obtain DoD/DoS Secret Clearance
