Quality Control Manager

This is a Proposal Position. The purpose of this job posting is to identify Key Personnel for a Base Operations Support Services (BOSS) project based in Djibouti, Africa. Candidates selected for the proposal will have first consideration pending a contract award.

Provides specialized technical expertise in support of the Quality program, including specialized inspection and testing techniques, quality training, statistical methods, audits, quality tools for problem solving and assessment.

QA Supervisor has overall responsibility for developing and implementing ISO compliant quality control, recommending changes and corrective actions as necessary to assure that quality services are provided in each functional area of the contract in a safe, timely, and cost efficient manner. Conducts periodic inspections, and develops and evaluates self-inspection data. Develops and conducts sampling plans, and implements and monitors corrective action if deficiencies are revealed. Reports to both the Project Manager and to our Corporate Office on problems areas, inadequacies of quality control, safety and safety-related environmental plans, and quality implications of work orders. Evaluates and responds to customer complaints.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible to administer, schedule and conduct inspections in satellite/remote locations for all functional and service areas to include: Facilities Support, Utilities, Construction, PRT Projects, Case Support and Environmental, as well as other functional and service areas listed in the Performance of Work Statement (PWS) and Statement of Work (SOW)
- Under general direction, is accountable for the performance and results of a related discipline or sub-group within a function.
- Applies knowledge of quality systems and tools to validate and verify contractually required standards for project execution.
- Manages the delivery of functional objectives by providing leadership and direction to team members.
- Implements principles of performance evaluation and prediction methods are used to improve product systems safety, reliability, and maintainability.
- Responsible for maintaining quality standard of products and the procedures and materials that go into work scope. Creates inspection

reports stating the conditions of a work area to ensure requirements are met.

- Makes recommendations for corrective action.
- Schedules and carries out audits of quality control functions and procedures in a timely, efficient, and unbiased manner
- Prepares and submits written reports of audit results to the Project Manager for action.

Requires:

- Bachelor's degree is preferred with 5 years of QA/QC experience on a large DoD Contract is a must
- Lean Six Sigma certification is a must
- Record of performing audits using the ISO 9001 criteria is a must
- Performing assessments utilizing the Malcolm Baldrige National Award Criteria.
- ISO Lead Auditor/Examiner certification is highly desired
- Ability to put together detailed presentation of data and information and present to an audience.
- Ability to develop and assist others on developing effective performance measures.
- Must have a current or ability to obtain DoD/DoS Secret Clearance
