Utilities Manager

This is a Proposal Position. The purpose of this job posting is to identify Key Personnel for a Base Operations Support Services (BOSS) project based in Djibouti, Africa. Candidates selected for the proposal will have first consideration pending a contract award.

Under broad direction, responsible for continued operations and throughput/output of base or camp utility systems. Independently applies advanced technical techniques and makes decisions on system operations, analyzes effectiveness, and ensures efficient operations. Responsible for study, design, specification and services related to utility systems performance and control including; power, water, and waste water, generation, transmission, distribution, storage, control centers, communications systems, cathodic protection, grounding lightning protection, heat tracing etc. Devises approaches and solutions to problems encountered. Plans, schedules, and leads work efforts for system maintenance, repairs and up-grades.

Responsibilities:

- Organizes and coordinates activities required to maintain and repair utilities equipment, systems, and components.
- Monitors system operations and ensures that proper functionality, trains utility system operators in preventive procedures.
- Directs system maintenance and preventative maintenance checks.
- Provides technical guidance to less experienced personnel.
- Plans, budgets, organizes, and controls work assignments.
- Interfaces with base /camp engineering and Public Works Office counterparts.
- Ensures compliance with company, OSHA and DOD safety policies.

Requires:

- Undergraduate degree (Engineering/Construction/Utility Systems) or related area, with a minimum of 10 years related experience.
- Professional registration or certification is valued.
- Previous assignments and recent work history support Navy/DOD BOS or Facility Support operations in austere or remote environments.
- Demonstrated skills, knowledge or techniques in work prioritization and supervisory skills for management of mixed labor work force.

- Excellent customer relations, communication, leadership, and interpersonal skills.
- Must have a current or ability to obtain DoD/DoS Secret Clearance
- Prefer experience with contingency support operations.
